Business day means a day on which you were scheduled to attend a class. Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation at School address shown on the front page of this Catalog or as noted on the Enrollment Agreement. You can do this by mail, in person, by FAX or telegram. The notice of cancellation, if mailed, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state you wish to cancel the agreement. You will be given two notices of cancellation forms on the first day of class. If the student has received Financial Aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of money not paid from federal student financial aid program funds. Business day means a day on which you were scheduled to attend a class. Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation at School address shown on the front page of this Catalog or as noted on the Enrollment Agreement. You can do this by mail, in person, by FAX or telegram. The notice of cancellation, if mailed, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state you wish to cancel the agreement. You will be given two notices of cancellation forms on the first day of class. If you cancel your enrollment, the School will refund any money that you paid within 30 days after your notice is received. [CA Ed Code §94911(e); §94919(b)]

A student officially dropping a course through the Registrar will receive prorated tuition and course fee refunds. If a student officially drops prior to the first class day of the course, AIS will refund full tuition. Students who officially drop after the first session but before completing 60% of the course will receive a prorated refund of the unused portion of tuition and other refundable charges. No refund will be made if a student drops after completing 60% of the course.

Program termination must be done correctly to prevent adverse financial and academic consequences. Students choosing to withdraw completely from AIS (quit the school) must notify the Admission's Office by completing a Complete Withdrawal form. The Registrar will process the form and note the withdrawal in the student's record as of a specific date. The withdrawing student must settle his or her financial account at the time of withdrawal. The termination procedure has added importance for international students. International students who do not properly terminate their program of study will be out of status and required to leave the US immediately. Please see the Admission Office for details.

You have the right to withdraw from School at any time. If you withdraw from the course of instruction after the cancellation period as in Par 1, AIS will remit a refund less a registration fee, not to exceed the lesser amount of 5% of costs or \$75.00 within 30 days following your withdrawal. You are obligated to pay only for educational services rendered and unreturned equipment. The refund shall be the amount you paid for instruction multiplied by fraction. The numerator of which is the number of hours of instruction, which you have not received, but for which you have paid, the denominator of which is the total number of hours of instruction for which you have paid. If you obtain books, uniform(s) and/or equipment, as specifically noted in this catalog and/or on your Enrollment Agreement, and return it in good condition within 30 days following the date of your withdrawal, the school shall refund the amount paid by you for equipment.
